



Based on a recommendation from the P5 Quota Committee, all P5 Boards have approved nine fall incentive days. Producers will be issued non-cumulative Additional Production Days as follows: two days each month for August, September, and November 2012, and three days for October 2012.

These days are issued to help flatten out the seasonal production curve by stimulating more fall milk production. There is no current recommendation to adjust production signals to producers for the rest of this winter and the spring. The Quota Committee continues to monitor market and milk production trends.

Producers are encouraged to contact the DFNS office if they require assistance calculating the impact of this announcement.
