

**SOP 14 - Prevention of the Introduction of Infectious Disease by Family, Employees, Farm Visitors and Service Providers**

*SOP must contain enough information to ensure that staff understand the measures that are taken on your farm to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. Items in **bold** are required/mandatory items.*

- **Prior to entering the production unit, ALL visitors are required to have (check all that apply):**
  - o **clean (wash and disinfected) boots (at a minimum)**
  - o disposable boots
  - o overshoes
  - o clean coveralls
  
- **Disposable boots and coveralls are to be disposed of \_\_\_\_\_ (identify the designated area for the disposal of disposable coveralls and boots)**
- **Provide and maintain a washing station (hands, boots) that can be used prior to entering the production unit. This is located \_\_\_\_\_**
  
- Plan ahead for all visits by requiring visitors to make appointments. Inform visitors of biosecurity requirements
- Keep a record of all visitors and deliveries
- Designate a specific parking area for visitors and employees
- Ensure that all farm workers (including yourself and family members) use farm dedicated clothing and footwear
- Require all coveralls to be cleaned on a routine basis
- Identify other biosecurity practices that are implemented on your farm:
  
- **List biosecurity measures for visitors and service personnel to follow, depending on the level of risk that each visitor could pose**
