SOP must contain enough information to ensure that staff understand the measures that are taken on your farm to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. Items in **bold** are required/mandatory items.

- Prior to entering the production unit, ALL visitors are required to have (check all that apply):
 - clean (wash and disinfected) boots (at a minimum)
 - disposable boots
 - o overshoes
 - o clean coveralls

- Ensure that all farm workers (including yourself and family members) use farm dedicated clothing and footwear
- Require all coveralls to be cleaned on a routine basis
